### **Showcase Concert – Elder Hall Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> September**

**All students to wear Suzuki uniform, including soloists who will need to change their outfits during the performance. Ticket prices are \$25 for Adults and \$15 for concession. Preschool aged children are free.**

**1:20 – 1:45** – All performers will be required to enter the hall with their parents. **We ask that students come immediately to the stage for seating and tuning.** Parents will find seating in the auditorium. Please keep enough seats spare for any children who will be performing **ONLY** in the opening Tutti items and Thank you Dr. Suzuki.

Special seating will be put aside for intermediate/senior students and soloists who are performing in other concert items.
